# **Before Creating a PDF**

- Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact Norhayati Soin at norhayatisoin@um.edu.my for the appropriate copyright notice. Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact Badariah Bais at badariah@vlsi.eng.ukm.my for the appropriate copyright notice.
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

## **Creating your PDF eXpress Account**

#### First-time users should do the following:

- 1. Select the New Users Click Here link.
- 2. Enter the following:
  - 33782X for the Conference ID
  - your email address
  - a password
- 3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

*Previous users* of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
